



Cross Cultural Awareness Workshop

A multi-award winning anti-racism workshop that aims to create a more inclusive classroom or workplace. An inspiring workshop delivered by Students Against Racism, a group of young people from refugee and migrant backgrounds. Students share their personal stories of why they left their homelands, their journey to Australia and their life now in Tasmania. Activities are tailored to the audiences and will inspire and educate.

Outcomes:

- An understanding of the forms and consequences of racism and how it can be addressed.
- Build cross cultural awareness of people from different backgrounds.
- Enhance multicultural empathy.

Format: This workshop (one to two hours) is presented by members of Students Against Racism in schools, workplaces and at conferences and events.
